






Why Are So Many Unreached? Few or No Ways to Hear the Gospel

- Very few Christians / churches / missionaries
- Nobody praying for them (by name)
- No Bible or New Testament
- No Jesus video/movie
- Little or no Christian literature / tracts / radio / TV / internet




The 10/40 Window represents a strategic area of the world for reaching UPGs



- 97% are least evangelized
- 85% are poorest of the poor
- 97% of the unreached are in the 10/40 Window




Significant Persecution in 10/40 Window






How Should Missionaries Be Distributed?








Missionary in India/Nepal



Fewest Missionaries to Muslims





Spending Far More on Buildings than on the Gospel

- American Christians spent enough money on new buildings to provide 360 Gospel booklets for every home
 - According to Dick Eastman and a 1977 Every Home for Christ publication sermon outline
 - That's almost one gospel booklet for every home on every day of the year!



What do we need in the U.S.?

- U.S. has more than her share of Christian finances, resources, and ministers.
- Our greatest need is NOT for more money to obey Great Commission
- Need obedient followers of Jesus with vision
- World-changers
- Attempt great things for God (William Carey)




David Barrett on Good Missions Stewardship


In 1997, David Barrett estimated that "Dollar for dollar and hour for hour, the harvest coming from the 10/40 Window nations outstrips that from the rest of the world 100 to 1. That is, if the same money and time spent to win one person to the Lord in the West were put to use in the 10/40 Window nations, the effort would yield a harvest of 100 souls added to the kingdom of God. It is 100 times more cost effective, therefore, to reach those in the 10/40 Window. But for a sizable number of ethnolinguistic groups, cost-effectiveness reaches 1000 times more than in Western countries."


Responsiveness to evangelism by country, 2010










- One every two seconds




What Can We Do?

Preparation for (Missionary) Living/Service

- Be flexible and unoffendable
- Be forgiving, gracious, & speak life
- Get stuck on God's awesomeness (not your imperfection)
- Practice living in peace (no anxiety/worry/fear)
- Carefully guard your heart/thoughts
 - Only consistent with God's word; no "orphan thinking"
- Live from identity as God's son/daughter
 - Completely forgiven and fully loved/accepted
- Practice recognizing God's leading and obeying
- Like Jesus, regularly declare God's word in prayer
- Develop missional lifestyle: self-feeding in Word, significant time with God, fellowship, outreach

Preparation for (Missionary) Living/Service

- Regularly pray for unreached
- Develop strong prayer life and relationship with Jesus
- Share your faith, make disciples, pray for the sick
- Eliminate debt, stay mobile, practice "wartime" lifestyle
- Give to frontier/UPG missions (beyond the tithe)
- Learn about people/group/language of interest
- Study/internship overseas, visit place of interest
- Meet & build relationships with unreached people
- Don't spend much time on things like TV, entertainment, video games, & social media
- Invest in healthy relationships (family/friends)
- Accountability partner to share and hold accountable
- Practice good integrated health, eating, exercise, & sleep

1974 Lausanne Covenant

The Urgency of the Evangelistic Task!

- More than 2,300 evangelical leaders from 150 countries in agreement!
- "... A reduction of foreign missionaries and money in an evangelised country may sometimes be necessary to facilitate the national church's growth in self-reliance and to release resources for unevangelised areas....
- Inadequate implementation (46 years)


